Thy Word

The Christian life is amazing! God works in us and through us in ways that thrill our souls. When we commit our lives to the Lord, his power is made manifest, even in our weakness. As Isaiah testifies of God, *“For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, says the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts”* (Is. 55:8-9). Praise God that he is our keeper – that he knows what is best for each of us and his church. So we declare with the psalmist, *“I lift my eyes to the hills. From whence does my help come?
