You are in Control of You

"You are in control of you." If you spent time with my family on a daily basis at home, you would hear those words quite often. One of the lessons we are trying to get our children to understand is that no one controls their actions except themselves. This is not an easy lesson for them to grasp. Let's be honest. While my kids may be struggling with the concept of being responsible for their actions, we know (and some of us may do this ourselves) many adults who struggle with this very same thing. So what does Paul mean when he writes about self-control being a fruit of the Spirit?

To really grasp this idea I think we need to understand the Jewish notion of shalom. Now many of you may have heard this word and even know the basic meaning for it, "peace." However, this word connotes so much more than just peace. Yes, our lives are to be peaceful. That also is a fruit of the Spirit. But shalom isn't about being a peaceful person. Shalom is about living a well-ordered life. See the Jews understood shalom as deriving from God. The only way a person could truly fulfill or experience shalom was through and because of God. Shalom comes from God. It is not something that we can achieve.

I think Paul is connecting the idea of self-control to shalom. Selfcontrol is a fruit of the Spirit. Meaning, it's given by the Spirit. It's not something I'm able to magically conjure when I want because I'm so great. Self-control is so much deeper than whether you were able to hold your tongue instead of lashing out at the person who cut you off in traffic yesterday. Self-control, true Spirit induced self-control, means that my whole life is oriented toward God. My life, my self, is controlled by the Spirit and what the Spirit desires. May we learn to experience the shalom, the selfcontrol, that the Spirit wants for our lives. -Adam Smith
