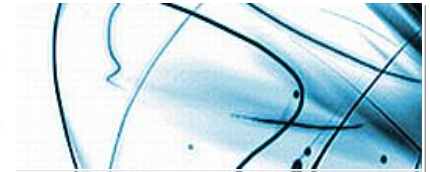

The Faithfulness of God

What does it mean to be faithful? Is faithfulness merely a synonym for loyalty? Can we say that a dog is faithful in the way that we might say it is loyal? I think the answer must be no. But what's the difference? How are faithfulness and loyalty not synonymous?

It might seem strange to think about the faithfulness of God. Yet over and over again in Scripture we are reminded that God was and is faithful. God was faithful to his promises to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. God was faithful to Moses as he led the people out of Egypt. God was faithful as he helped Joshua and the judges of Israel. God was faithful to David in trying to preserve the line of kings even after David's descendants were so unfaithful to God.

Faithfulness, as one of the fruit of the Spirit, is about more than just loyalty. God wasn't just loyal to his people. God has been and is faithful to see his will fulfilled in this world. God has been and is faithful to those who remain faithful to him. God will always follow through on his end of the covenant.

I think that's what Paul has in mind when he says that faithfulness is a fruit of the Spirit. We are obligated to uphold our end. We aren't meant just to be loyal to God; but faithful. I can be loyal to many friends or many people in my life; I can only be faithful to one wife. I can be loyal to my job or other things that I might enjoy; I can only be faithful to one God. Faithfulness is a fruit of the Spirit living inside us. If our faithfulness is not to God alone then we are unfaithful. For Israel, faithfulness looked like keeping the law and maintaining religious purity. For us it looks like loving God and loving others. May our faithfulness grow each day as we discern how God is demanding our faithfulness today in 2017. That kind of faithfulness can only come from the Spirit.-Adam Smith
