To the Author of Life

"In the beginning, God created...." So begin the scriptures. Since that time the world has been turning, stars shining, and new life springing forth daily to fill that world. God's design can be seen each morning as the sun comes up. He can be seen when newly planted seeds begin sprouting in the fields. He is the author of life who created everything, finely tuned to work together flawlessly. The scriptures go on to speak about how creation points to God: "God's invisible qualities can be seen from all that has been created," Romans 1:20; "But ask the animals, and they will teach you, or the birds in the sky, and they will tell you," Job 12:7; "In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land," Psalm 95:4-5.

Knowing how perfectly God authored the world around us we should ask ourselves a question, "Are we letting God be the author of our lives?" Most of us could probably say we hold on a little too tight to our lives, and want to write our own stories.

It can be scary to place our lives completely in the hands of God. He may shape us into something we didn't expect. He may take us places we never wanted to go. It may mean we let go of things we wanted. Yet, we are called to give up our lives to follow him.

In a song titled, "Author of Life," Phil Joel wrestles about the difficulty of giving his life over to God. He writes, "Things aren't exactly what I thought they would be, I won't pretend...Swallow my pride, let go inside, show me your ways, refine me and I'll still love you." As we to struggle to let God be the author of our lives, let us continually look, "unto Jesus, the author and perfector of our faith who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross..."
