The Good, the bad, the ugly

I remember as a kid always wanting my parents to praise me. It's a very natural thing. Kids seek the approval of those they deem to be the most directly influential people in their lives. For me, as I'm sure for many of you, that was my parents. I remember wanting to hear the words: "I'm proud of you," "You did a good job," and, "Well done."

Now, not everything I did was good. Nor did I do everything well. But I remember the words "Good job" often in my life. And why not? My parents were proud of me. They wanted me to feel accomplished and proud of what I had done. But I did a lot of stupid things in my childhood as well. I did a lot of things that would classify as bad or ugly.

One of the fruit of the Spirit is goodness. I've pondered over the meaning of that word many times. But am I good? Are we good? Jesus himself says, "'Why do you call me good?' Jesus asked. 'Only God is truly good" (Mark 10:18). What?!?! Could my parents have been wrong this whole time?

I think what Jesus means by this is not that we cannot accomplish good or positively meaningful projects and enterprises. I don't think Jesus means that we can't have personalities or habits that lift up others rather than tear them down. I don't think Jesus means that our actions are useless since they can't be good and that we should just give up now. In fact, I think the very opposite. I think Jesus means to say that our actions are infinitely worthwhile because all goodness comes from God. When Paul lists goodness as one of the fruit of the Spirit, Paul is trying to get the Galatians, and us, to understand that the goodness the Spirit provides is the same goodness which resided in Jesus and is only manifest because the Father himself is infinitely and graciously good. May we seek the goodness the Spirit offers and make goodness a daily habit.
