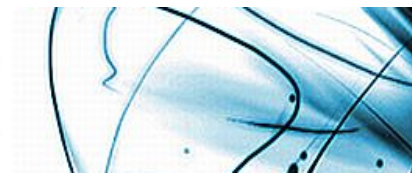

## Crucified With Christ

### "Condemned to Die"

A Life With Christ has a very unusual and interesting beginning. We have to be crucified with Christ. You say, wait a minute! Wasn't Christ crucified for us? So why then do we have to be crucified? Because of sin, as Paul writes, "*we all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God*" (Rom. 3:23). The great prophet Isaiah gives us this picture of sin. "*Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save, or his ear dull, that it cannot hear; but your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you so that he does not hear*" (Is. 59:1-2). You see, in our sinful state, we stand **condemned to die!** We are "*separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world*" (Eph. 2:12).

"*Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord!*" (Rom. 7:24-25). Yes, Jesus is the one who "*bore our sins in his body on the cross that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed*" (1 Pet. 2:24). We were **condemned to die**, but he died for us. That means we die to sin when we are united with Christ's death in baptism. "*We know that our old self was crucified with him so that the sinful body might be destroyed, and we might no longer be enslaved to sin*" (Rom. 6:6). We were **condemned to die**, but Christ took our place and paid the sin debt. "*And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires*" (Gal. 5:24). That means we have indeed been crucified with Christ, and we now live A Life With Christ! Praise God that through Christ Jesus we are no longer **condemned to die!** -Gordon
