A Reflection on Psalm 23

Psalm 23: The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures.

He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies, you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

This is one of the all-time popular scriptures, and for good reason. There are many themes addressed in its words which are powerful to humanity: basic needs of life, safety, fear, death, comfort, eternity. However, there is one theme, not explicitly mentioned, but more of evoked from this psalm which I think leads to its popularity...peace.

So many people in this world search peace. Peace in the home; peace at work; world peace. Peace can be hard to come by. Peace requires that things are in order or happening as they should be; a lack of selfishness needed for peace between people.

This passage both begins and ends with the Lord, "The Lord is my shepherd...I shall dwell in the house of the Lord...." Peace can indeed be found in the Lord. If you find yourself full of tension, stress or worry, I encourage you to meditate on this passage and thousands have done before you. Picture the scenes it crafts in your mind, read it slowly, take deep breaths as you spend time in peace. -Erik Granberg
