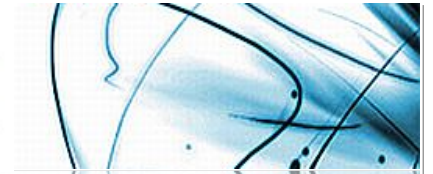

### Psalm 23

I remember well the feeling I had as a child when I got separated from my parents in one of the department stores in Enid. Fear overwhelmed me and I felt so lost and helpless. Yet, when I found my parents I felt safe and secure again. All of my fears vanished in a heartbeat. But one thing for sure, I was determined to never lose sight of my parents again. You see, within our very nature is a need to feel protected. We need someone there to pick us up when we fall. We need someone to guide us on our pathway through life. We need someone we can turn to when the challenges of life overwhelm us. And the answer is: **The Lord is my Shepherd!** God is looking out after us when we get lost. He is there to guide us through life.

That is why the psalmist can so confidently say "**The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall not want.**" We are his sheep. He takes care of our life's needs for food and water.
