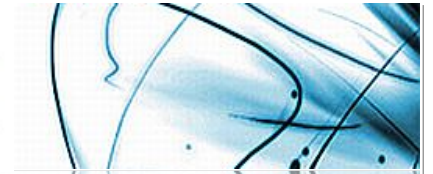

Life Group Questions

Scripture: John 5:19

Thought: Jesus was with God in heaven, but when he took on human flesh, he became just like us. Weary to Our Bones

One of the biggest threats to our relationship with God and great barrier to our quality of life is not immorality or secularism or humanism but simply this: we are too busy. A typical day: hit the alarm to snooze, repeat, coffee, pack lunches, kisses running out the door, fighting traffic, arriving 10 minutes late, more coffee, meetings, deadlines, practices, doctors' appointments...exhaustion. Good things, productive things, God things...all add more, more and more to be done.

Eliminate hurry from your life. It sounds good, but isn't that being lazy? If we are not wearing ourselves out, then are we truly dedicated? Has anyone who accomplished anything for God ever completely eliminated the hurry and had a healthy rhythm of life?

There was one. One who lived a centered life and yet accomplished all he needed. He was active and busy, but not hurried and fretful. He had a healthy rhythm of life that trusted in God for direction and power...his name was Jesus.

You saw that coming, didn't you?

Jesus was a carpenter, walked everywhere, had people clamoring to touch him, was constantly bombarded with questions, constantly under scrutiny, yet...he still felt time to withdraw, "But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed," (Luke 5:16). Can we have the same peaceful, focused, unhurried life as Jesus? Yes, we can...by following His lead.
