

#### Empowered for Kingdom Work

**Scripture:** Ephesians 2:10

## Being Spirit Led

I'm often amazed at myself, though I'm not sure why, at how much I try to control everything around me. From situations, to circumstances, to people, I imagine that I'm the one in control. I imagine that what I want is of first importance. I imagine that it's all about me.

Two weeks ago I traveled with some of our high school students and Sandy Lindsay on an incredible mission trip. This is a trip I'd been excited about since last summer. I called it our "Spirit led" trip. Contrary to other mission trips we do, like going to Manuelito every summer, I didn't know where we were headed nor what kind of service we would be engaging in.

For the past few months we had been planning the trip together. The high schoolers helped me budget for the trip, make decisions about what we would eat, and how many nights we might stay in a hotel. But we did it all under the authority and guidance of the Spirit through prayer. In other words, we tried as best we could to make this trip about what God wanted us to do rather than what we wanted. So we planned for the kinds of service opportunities God might send our way, but we didn't know if we'd do any of them at all. It turns out that when you let God take control, he's pretty good about showing up in just the right ways.

I wish I had the space to tell you everything about the trip. Feel free to grab me or any of the others who went as we'd be more than happy to give you all of the great details. Instead I want to close with this. "But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things! Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives" (Gal. 5:22, 23, & 25).
