

**Scripture:** Acts 2

**Thought:** You hear me say often that as Christians we are living by the Spirit. One of the benefits of being a community pharmacist is getting to know different people, from all walks of life. As I have gotten to know these folks, all have something to ask or tell you.

Usually it's medical, sometimes personal, but "their story" is always interesting. I heard thousands of stories and thought I had heard them all until a certain day in May, 2016. A certain elderly gentleman came in that morning, needing a couple of refills. I have known Mr. "x" for 20 years or so. He was always very friendly and conversational, but I never had heard his story until that day. While waiting on approval for one of his refills, he started telling me about his wife and her family. How she passed away and how 2 other family members had died within 3 days of each other. His wife's death was sudden, and he regretted that he was not at home when she died. (Note as a pharmacist I have heard lots of stories like this but this is when it gets interesting) He told me how difficult it was at her funeral and he was really having a very hard time at the cemetery. He said after everyone left, he started weeping and praying for 20 minutes; just asking for God's help. He felt a cool breeze come over him. He looked up and saw his daddy walking with his wife, and his dad told him that she was with Jesus now and she was ok. I was dumbfounded and was trying to understand just what he said. So my science fact finding side asked, "you saw a heavenly scene at the cemetery?" Yes, he said, and that he had seen Jesus with angels several times during his life. And then he told me different stories from his youth to his current age about his revelations. When he was 8 or 9, one evening his mom and dad could not find the cows for milking. So he started praying to help his family find the cattle. Soon Jesus told him where they were, and his parents and brother found them just where he said they would be.

I share this story to show you the power of testimony. Never hesitate to tell others your story as it relates to the gospels. Let's remember to pray like Mr. "x" with the assurance our loved ones are with Jesus now.
