We Are Two In One

We are two bodies in one. One body is physical...made of flesh and bone. These bodies have 5 senses: sight, taste, touch, sound, and smell. We use these to determine what we should eat for lunch, movies to watch, or outfits to put on in the mornings. When it comes to business and careers we can use statistics, analytics, and budgets. If we get sick we can go to the doctor who will take our temperature, check our vitals, run tests, then prescribe a remedy. Most of these rely on hard, concrete, physical evidence.

Our other body is spiritual. Not visible to human eyes and much more difficult to measure, observe, or understand. Paul says in Romans 8:5, "... those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace." Christians are confronted with the difficult task of seeing things from a spiritual perspective when everything around us is geared toward the physical.

So today I want to give just a few simple ways to help us try and view things more with minds that are set on "things of the Spirit." First, don't just follow your first impulse or thought. It is easy for those first reactions to be things of the flesh. Second, pray. Ask the trinity to work in your life with whatever is at hand. Third, meditate on the scriptures. Most often there are a few scriptures that address something we are dealing with, find those scriptures, and think about them daily. Finally, seek and listen to Godly counsel.

Putting these four suggestions into practice may seem like it will take a lot of work. Guess what...you're right. It is hard work to listen to God, it is hard to push down our physical impulses, and it hard to have the patience to think about things from a spiritual point of view.
