Crucified With Christ

"Nail Scars"

I bear a permanent scar from childbirth. It is from a bright red birthmark I had on my right forearm. The doctor that treated it tried something that had never been done before. He wrapped some dry ice over it and left it there for a period of time. It caused a huge blister, but when the blister healed, the red birthmark was gone. All that was left is the scar I still carry to this day. Over the years, I have showed this scar to countless people and shared my story about it. Each of us has scars resulting from surgeries, accidents, carelessness, and from many other causes. They can be physical, emotional or spiritual. Whatever the cause they remain part of us as a reminder of how they occurred.

Our Lord and Savior also sustained a permanent birthmark when he was born into human form. His birthmark was caused by the sinfulness of mankind. "But God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8). Peter also writes, "He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed" (1 Pet. 2:24). His birthmark is the nail scars he sustained by being nailed to the cross. God held our sins against his body, just as the doctor did the dry ice on my arm, and it left nail scars in his hands. Let us not doubt this eternal healing process like Thomas did, one that had never been done before either. He said, "Unless I see in his hands the print of the nails, and place my finger in the mark of the nails, and place my hand in his side, I will not believe" (Jn. 20:25). But when Thomas saw the nail scars, he cried out "My Lord and my God!" (Jn. 20:28). Look into your hands and see the nail scars Jesus bore for us. They are ours! Praise the Lord, we have been healed! -Gordon Jantz
