I am reminded of the story of the little bird who decided to stay behind and not fly south for the winter with his friends. He told his friends there is plenty of time before it turns cold and I like it here a lot. So he chose to stay behind. (Life is like that) Things were going good until one day the temperature dropped to freezing. He knew he needed to do something so he made a choice to fly south to catch up with his friends and be warm for the winter. So off he flew. It got colder and colder then there was ice and sleet. The little bird knew he was in trouble because he had made the choice to wait too long to fly south. (You know life is like that) It got so bad, the little bird's wings froze up and no longer fly. He fell from the sky and landed in a farmer's barn yard. He was frozen and couldn't move or make a sound. Just about the time he thought he was a goner, a cow walked by and dropped a cow patty right on top of him. (Sometimes life is like that) The heat in the cow patty began to warm up the frozen bird and he thawed out. He was so happy to be warm and alive, he began to chirp and sing.
