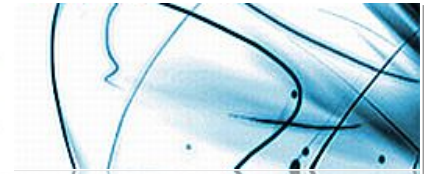

Do Not Worry!

Among all God's creation, only humans can anticipate future events. This ability is a blessing, but it is a curse whenever it is misused. Have you ever had times when you go to bed, but cannot sleep because you are worrying about a difficult time looming ahead? Do you get up in the morning worrying about tasks which need to be done today or in the future and measuring them against your own strength and weakness? Often times we over analyze the situation or the problem to the point we become paralyzed and don't do anything.

Matthew 6:25-34: Jesus says, "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes?" He then explains how God takes care of the birds and feeds them. Then he asks a question, "Are you not much more valuable than they? Who of you by WORRYING can add a single hour to his life?"

Verse 32: "Your Heavenly Father knows what you need. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."

Verse 34: "Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough troubles of its own."

So if we want to have a life of joy, peace and contentment, we need to take care of today and walk daily with the prince of peace Jesus Christ!
