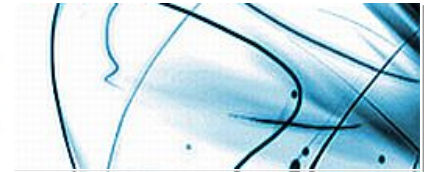

Known by the Lord

Psalm 139

Psalms 139 is one of my favorites - it shows us the intimacy God has with us - it tells us God knows us through and through. We may be able to hide things from our parents - our spouses - our friends - our bosses, but we cannot hide anything from God. The psalmist writes, *"You have searched me, Lord, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you, Lord, know it completely."* If you are like me, that makes me squirm a little. How many times have we looked around to see if anyone was watching before we did something? Nothing escapes God's attention because we are indeed **known by the Lord!** This is not to make us feel bad, but to constantly be a reminder of how he wants us to live in faithful obedience to his commands. That is why the psalmist tells us we are the sheep of his pasture, and he loves us with all his divine being. Verses 5 & 6 are priceless. *"You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain."* God is determined to lead us in the pathway of righteousness. If we go the wrong way, he blocks our path. When we try to go the other direction, he again interrupts us. Even when we try to crawl over the fence, his hand is upon us. This is powerful knowledge for us - it lies beyond our comprehension. How precious is the confidence of the psalmist when he asks God to *"Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."* That is the heart of a true believer that is **known by the Lord.** -Gordon Jantz
