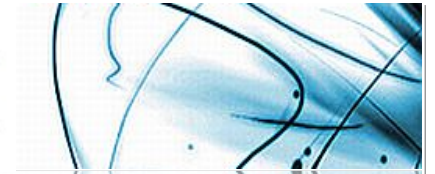

Listed below are some excerpts from that article.

## Today Is My Choice
