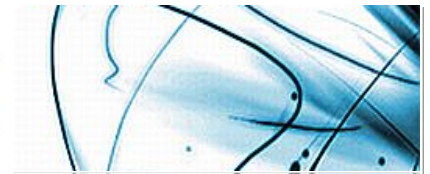

### Life Group Questions

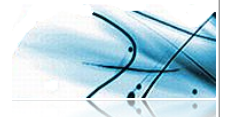
**Scripture:** Deuteronomy 6:1-13

### The Lord's Help

**Psalm 121** - There are many things about my dad that reflect the attributes of God. He was my strength and shield. As I went about doing things, I knew he would always be there to help me when I needed it. That gave me confidence in myself, and I always felt secure in his presence. I learned to respect him through his loving discipline - molding me to be a moral and trustworthy person. He taught me a strong work ethic and allowed me to serve and experience life to the fullest.

That is the message the psalmist seeks to communicate to us about our heavenly Father. He says, *"I lift up my eyes to the mountains - where does my help come from? **My help comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth.**"* It doesn't get any better than that. The God of creation is the one who gives us strength to carry out the work he has given us, and shields us from the devastating forces of Satan. We have the assurance that *"He will not let your foot slip - he who watches over you and will... neither slumber nor sleep."* **The Lord's help** is always with us. As the Hebrew writer states, *"He will never leave us or forsake us"* (Heb. 13:5). His presence is always with us - he walks with us and talks with us along life's narrow way. **The Lord's help** is there as we engage in kingdom work - as we serve him and his people. He equips us for the work of ministry, and then sends us out in to the fields of harvest to save lost souls. Life is so fulfilling when we follow in his steps. We too learn to respect God through His discipline. He wants us to be moral and trustworthy servants. That is why *"The Lord will keep you from all harm - he will watch over your life; the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore."* Praise God for **the Lord's help.** *Gordon*
