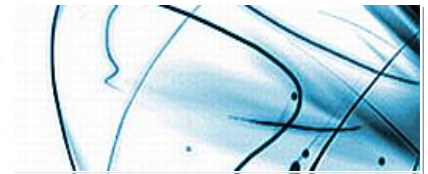

Teaching of the Lord

Psalm 78

Think for a moment how your life has been impacted and molded by the teachers you have had. Which ones stand out the most? The easy ones that didn't challenge you very much, or those that made you work hard - that challenged you to be your very best? As for me, it is those who cared enough about me to help me find my inner strength and ability. As a college professor told me after making the best grade in the class on an exam, "I expect better from you!" It is the **teaching of those** who have made me who I am today.

The psalmist reminds us that the **teaching of the Lord** guides us on a successful path through life toward our eternal home in heaven. *"O my people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth."* You see, God cares enough for us to help us find our inner strength and ability. It lies within his holy and righteous teaching. It is for our spiritual well being - not only for us, but for our children and the generations to come. *"We will not hide them from our children; we will tell the next generation the praise worthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done."* Again the psalmist reminds us what happens when we fail to listen to the **teaching of the Lord**. We fall away - we succumb to Satan's temptations - we turn our backs on God. Yet, *"God is merciful; he forgives our iniquities and does not destroy us - he brought his people out like a flock - he brought them to the border of his holy land - he drove out nations before them."* Guess what his people did? They continued *"to put God to the test and rebelled against the most high."* Why? Because they were disobedient to the **teaching of the Lord**. Just as God gave Israel David to shepherd and lead them, so has he given us Jesus to lead us in the **teaching of the Lord**.
