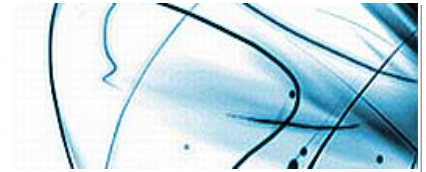

Bible School have started!

Last month we started the Bible school hand in hand with the Seyer training center. We offer bible courses in the morning and Automotive mechanic training in the afternoon. The students are learning to fix both diesel and gas engines. They are also learning to do welding on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. On Saturday they are learning sewing or tailoring. The training is designed for one year only so they have their hands full everyday going through intensive training. In between classes they have a devotional everyday. We want them to be "tent makers" after they graduate.

We have good teachers for their Bible courses. So far, we have had two guest teachers from Texas Bob Buchanan and Ken Wilkey. Bob taught "How to study the Bible and enjoy it,"while Ken taught "The Scheme of Redemption." For their everyday class we have two good Filipino teachers, Dennis Bello and Jojo Recomono. In October we are looking forward for Michael Manley coming and be a guest teacher for a week. We hope there are others from North Garland to come and help teach our students either Bible subjects or vocational training. I'm so glad that our former mechanic teacher is back, he is probably the best mechanic in the entire island where we live. I'm praying we will be able to keep him.

Most of all, we really need your prayers for the mission work here. We are also looking forward to having the irrigation project done at the Ron Nelsons' farm. We have just harvested more than 6000 pounds of corn for food, it is a staple here. With the irrigation we could have more harvest.
