### Thankful for the...Pain and Suffering?

The holiday season is upon us, and all that comes with it. The air is getting cold, and the leaves are changing colors. Sparkling lights are appearing on businesses and houses. The smells and tastes of seasonal food surround us: peppermint hot chocolate, turkey and dressing, homemade pies.

We take time during this season to reflect upon the blessings we have been given. Perhaps we are thankful for a new job with stable income, a family with whom we can get together, a warm place to live when the temperature drops. We also give thanks for God's grace and forgiveness.

These are all important things to be thankful for. However, as you read this, I want to give you something else to be thankful for, pain and suffering. Because of all that is going on in the world around us, both near and far, now is a good time to reflect on this.

There is a direct correlation between suffering and some of humanities greatest characteristics. When people are in need, others sacrifice to meet the needs. The suffering of one person, produces compassion in another. As disaster strikes, others respond with giving, which in turn produces gratefulness. Without hate, we would not know the power of love. Without knowing the bad times, we would not know hope for the good times. In turmoil, we come to appreciate peace.

The apostle Paul, in the letter he wrote to the church in Rome, speaks to this idea in Romans 5:1-6. Take time this season to reflect upon his words, "...we rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.... God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
