Forgiving With Christ

"Forgive and Forget"

Think back to the time you did something wrong and knew an undesirable consequence was coming. What did you hope for when the powers at be found out and confronted you with it? Could it be that you hoped they would forgive you and even forget the whole situation? This was certainly my heart's desire when I accidentally shot a hole in our stock tank. I missed the precious little bird by about a foot and the stock tank leaked the rest of the time we lived on the farm. Dad was certainly not a happy camper when he discovered my blunder. Praise the Lord he was able to forgive me and as far as I know, he even forgot how it happened.

When we consider our life with God, we shudder when we realize how we have displeased him by the things we have done. We all stand condemned to die because we "all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23). There is no way we can stand before the eternal judge and plead our case hoping he will forgive and forget. We have done wrong - we deserve to be punished - we must face the consequence. But wait, there is one who steps before the judge and testifies on our behalf and tells the judge he will take the punishment we deserve. "For our sake he made him [Jesus] to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God" (2 Cor. 5:21). Wow! That is exactly what we had hoped for even though we were totally undeserving. Praise God for his abundant love and grace that he would forgive and forget our sins because of the sacrifice of Christ. The psalmist testifies, "Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
