RON NELSON'S FARM "OVERFLOWETH"

Last week we drove the big Hino truck (a gift from North Garland 3 years ago), filled it with water hoses from Cebu, where irrigation materials are much cheaper. We then put the Hino on an overnight boat to Bato,Leyte and then drove for five hours northwest to Naval, Biliran where the Nelson farm is located. I brought Brother Roel, an expert carpenter and plumber, who built the reservoirs and spring box earlier. The irrigation system is entirely run by gravity since the spring is located up in the slope (absolutely, no electric or diesel bill!) What a great blessing!

There's too much water and I think we only tap 25 percent of the spring, the rest are freely flowing to the stream. The rice field is now covered and we are planning to work on the cornfield by the first week of December. We will build another reservoir for the corn field to store water and create a good water pressure gravity-based system too. I'm not an engineer or farmer by trade, but I am trying our best to utilize and get the most out of the land to help widows, orphans, our students, and those in need. Having the new irrigation system, we can now plant & harvest three times a year, instead of two. We can plant during the dry season, when we have little rain, when demand is great and supply is not enough. With the irrigation system, we can also rotate crops better, to help rebuild up the soil.

Since there's too much water overflowing from the reservoir, we were able to tap some of it for running water to the church building for drinking, bathrooms, cooking etc. I think six families now near the church building have running water for the first time as well. Even my little room behind the church building now has a shower. The irrigation project is literally creating an "overflowing" of blessings for the church and the Christians there. We are so thankful and grateful for North Garland being able to fund this special project at the Nelson farm. It will be a gift that blesses the work for many years to come, it will help the churches' "cup overfloweth"! Thank you all so much, the Emperado family love you all!
