Scripture: 1 Samuel 8:1-7

Thought: Today's sermon covered the account of Israel asking for a king to rule over them. In so doing, God said they have rejected him as their king. - 3. What good, godly examples can we seek to imitate?
- 4. What stood out to you from today's sermon?

"Attitude Check"

Someone recently made the comment, "It isn't just doing the right thing that counts, what also matters is your attitude WHILE you do it." I have been reflecting on that since then, and if I'm being honest I really struggle with that. Doing the right thing isn't a problem most of the time (I can even post a smile on my face while doing it), but my internal attitude is just so hard to bend in the right direction.

Paul says in Philippians 2:1-5, "Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus...." Notice the number of times he references and internal aspect: like-minded, spirit, ambition, conceit, and so on. A wrong mind-set can be easy to cover up. Show up with a smile and a laugh and people will get the idea that you are excited to be where you are doing what you're doing, but you know the truth, so does God.

Don't get me wrong, sometimes we must do things even when we don't want to. I am a firm believer in acting ourselves into a right attitude. But most times, we are the only ones who truly know if we are working on improving our attitude or have just given up.

As you go about your life this week, take some time occasionally to take an attitude check. Are you doing things begrudgingly or out of joy? Are you helping someone because you are "supposed" to or because you want to make a difference? If you find your attitude is not what it should be, then say a prayer asking that God give you thoughts of empathy, joy, compassion, dedication, or passion.--Erik Granberg
