Maturing in Faith

Have you noticed that many nursery rhymes are dark? Take "Rock-A-Bye Baby." A baby is in a cradle hanging from a tree branch. When the wind breaks the tree branch the cradle, baby and tree branch all come crashing down in a great big mess. Must be Oklahoma where "the wind comes sweeping down the plains." The baby is left in a great big mess due to no fault of its own. Babies, infants, are too young to do anything against the forces acting upon them. Fortunately, we grow up.

In **Ephesians 4:14**, Paul uses the idea of infants in a storm to talk about faith, "Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ."

Just like people age physically, people can age spiritually. Hopefully over time they become mature in faith. Here are two ways that can help people mature in their faith. First, nourish the spiritual growth. In **Matthew 4:4** Jesus responds to the devil's temptation by quoting the Old Testament, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" Take time to spend in God's word, converse with people of faith, and take time to converse with God himself. Second, be sure to engage in spiritual exercise. Paul, says in **Ephesians 2:10**, "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works...." Did you catch that? God created us to work. Spend time helping your neighbor, take care of widows and orphans, feed the hungry. All of these are ways to physically exercise our spiritual faith, and hopefully, help us mature.
