"Having Spiritual Eyes"

As a supervisor and commander in the Air Force, I spent a good deal of my time looking after the interest of those who worked for me. I wanted them to feel valuable and to make sure they were focused on the mission we were responsible for. It was my belief that if I looked after their interest, they would return the favor by doing their jobs the best they could. That in turn, made me look good. The drawback to this was that at the end of the day, they all went home and I still had "my" work to do. That was a sacrifice I was willing to make for the success of my career.

As Christians, we are also encouraged to look after the interest of others. "Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interest of others" (Phil. 2:4). We certainly have to take care of ourselves, but we must be mindful of the needs of others. We do that by having spiritual eyes so we can see their needs even before they ask. It makes them feel valuable and helps them stay focused on their spiritual mission of serving in the Lord's kingdom. Having spiritual eyes allows us to see what the world doesn't - the heart and soul of God's precious people. It allows us to feel their pain and hear their sighs the way God does us. Having spiritual eyes allows us to see the spiritual forces God has assembled to give us victory in our battle against Satan. When the Syrian kings came down against Elisha, he prayed for God to open his servant's [spiritual] eyes so he could see. "So the Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw; and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha" (2 Kgs. 6:17). You see, God is always looking after the interest of others, and in turn, we are able to give our lives back to him as faithful servants.
