Know Who You Are

"Dear God, I love you. How are you? Fine I hope. I'm fine too. My mother has five girls and one boy. I am one of them. Nancy"

It is always good to know who you are. Unfortunately, sometimes we can get so caught up in doing, doing, doing that our days and months can be eaten up by busyness and our identities consumed by a never-ending flood of tasks. How many of us might be better defined sometimes as a "Human Doing" rather than a "Human Being"? Nancy is only 6 years old, so she doesn't define herself by what she does. She's got a mother with five girls and a boy and she's one of them. She is a daughter and a sister in a family that loves her. She's secure in who she is and, therefore, can say with confidence "I'm fine too". Somewhere along the way we grow up and too often begin to define ourselves by what we do and forget who we are.

The Gospel of Luke tells the story of two sisters, Mary and Martha. Jesus had come to their village and Martha invited him to their home so the people of the village could gather there and hear him teach. Mary sat down at Jesus' feet and listened as he spoke to the people of the village. But Martha got caught up in being the good hostess and "was distracted with much serving." I can only imagine her bustling about their home taking care of things while Mary just sat there. She must have been seething mad when she finally approached Jesus and said, "Don't you care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her to help me!"

Jesus answered, "Martha, Martha, you are worried about many things. But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

Martha had invited Jesus into her home and then got so busy *doing* things for him that she didn't spend any time *being with* him.

Obviously, we all have work, tasks, and responsibilities that must be done. Much of it is literally a matter of life and death! But in these very, very busy days don't lose yourself! Remember the words of the psalmist: *"Know that the Lord is God. It is he who has made us and not we ourselves.
