# Servant I'm the Greatest

I imagine each one of us has an internal desire to be great. We have a natural need to be recognized for our talents and abilities. That is what allows us to feel successful and be shown honor and respect. In terms of the recent 2018 Olympics, we want to win the Gold Medal! While it is good to strive for excellence and perfection, we must keep our focus on the true meaning of life. Our purpose in life is to be what God wants us to be. When we have done that, then we can proudly proclaim "**I'm the Greatest**!" The apostle Paul sets an example for us. He recounts why he should feel great and have confidence in the flesh. But then adds, "*But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ*" (Phil. 3:7). He was a true servant.

Jesus' disciples also had a yearning for being the "greatest in the kingdom of heaven." His response is stunning. "Calling to him a child, he put him in the midst of them, and said... Whoever humbles himself like this child, he is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven" (Matt. 18:1-4). That means we can say **I'm the greatest** when we humble our lives before God, confess Jesus as our Lord and put to death our fleshly desires for greatness in the waters of baptism. We then become like a child, being innocent and pure before our heavenly Father. We have no need to be recognized by the world that "**I'm the greatest**" because we already are before the God of all creation. The greatest thing about being the greatest as a child of God is that we have eternal life with in the glory of heaven. We have no need for someone to hang a Gold Medal around our neck, because we will be walking on *streets of pure gold*, *transparent as glass* (Rev. 21:21).
