Sermon Scripture: James 1:1-18

Sermon Thought: Everyone faces suffering. This suffering can come as drought, disease, violence, or as James mentions, the rich dragging the poor to court. James begins his letter by unexpectedly encouraging his brothers to respond with joy to their various trials. Not to enjoy suffering in some masochist way, but understanding that faith can be strengthened through: accidents, poverty, sickness, prosperity, knowledge, position in life or anything else that may come our way.

- 2. How would you describe the difference between a trial and a temptation?
- **3.** Trials can come from both a lack of or an overabundance of something. Sometimes our faith is tested by loss of health, at other times having too much money or time. How have you experienced these and what have you learned about yourself and faith?

Compassion

"Feeling What Others Feel"

Our journey of discipleship has been a very enlightening one for me. As the Spirit guides my thoughts to write each article, I gain a new insight into what being a disciple of Christ is all about. As I deal with various situations in life, I find myself reflecting on how Christ deals with me as one of his disciples. It changes my response because I am more sensitive to **how the people feel** I am dealing with. The things I read each day seem to open my eyes to a greater height of spiritual formation. You see, **feeling what others feel** is an essential part of discipleship because that is what God does for us.

"God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life" (Jn. 3:16). That means that God put himself in human flesh so he could feel what we feel. His Son, "though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men" (Phil. 2:6-7). The Hebrew writer tells us that while Jesus was in human flesh, "he in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin" (Heb. 4:15). As disciples of Christ, we have the same sense for **feeling what others feel** because "His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness" (2 Pet. 1:3). When we give our lives to Christ, we become one with him and have access to his divine power to overcome sin as we mature in our spiritual formation. We then have the ability to see others as Christ sees us. He guides us in caring for others so we can encourage their spiritual growth instead of tearing it down. It is only through his divine power that we can feel what others feel and guide them on their spiritual journey. What a glorious day it will be feeling what others feel through our eternal victory.
