"The Essence of God"

Love is an amazing thing. It is the essence and expression of the inner most part of our human existence. We exist because of love and it is the powerful force that motivates our daily actions and responses in our relationships with others. Dr. Scott Peck in his book "The Road Less Traveled" offers this definition of love. "The will to extend one's self for the purpose of nurturing one's own or another's spiritual growth." The apostle Paul also tells us "Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things" (1 Cor. 13:7).
