The Tablet of Your Heart

A while back I was not able to sleep. I tried all the usual. Counting sheep, melatonin, warm milk, etc. Nothing worked. Eventually I decided to start at Genesis and work through the Bible saying all the scripture I had memorized. Fell asleep right away! Actually, I didn't, but it was quite the adventure.

Since I started in Genesis, it began, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth...." went through 3-4 verses from that passage. I came to Deuteronomy and, "Love the Lord your God with all of your heart, soul, and mind." In Joshua, "Choose this day whom you will serve...as for me and my house we will serve the Lord." This continued through well-known passages like Psalm 23 and obscure ones that I like, such as Proverbs 26:18-19, "Like a maniac shooting flaming arrows of death is one who deceives his neighbor and says, 'I was only joking!"

With each verse I stopped and thought briefly about what it meant, reflecting upon what I could learn about God, and what he wanted me to learn. Ok, not really, I just want you to think I am super holy. What I was actually thinking was, "How long will it take until I fall asleep!" Eventually I did, somewhere around the middle of the New Testament because I don't remember thinking about Revelation at all.

One thing that did stand out to me was the amount of scripture that I do have memorized if I really concentrate on it. I would encourage anyone to find time to think of all the scriptures you have memorized, even if it isn't exact or you don't know the reference. It hasn't been until the last 150 years or so that Bibles have been easily accessible. Before that, people just relied upon their memories.

"My child, keep my words and store up my commands within you. Keep my commands and you will live; guard my teachings as the apple of your eye. Bind them on your fingers; write them on the tablet of your heart." -Proverbs 7:1-3
