Sermon Scripture: Mark 4:35-41

Sermon Thought: I want to share a thought from my family's vacation this past week at Corpus Christi. We found ourselves on the beach as a huge storm rolled in. The waves got bigger, the wind picked up, and the temperature dropped. We took a couple minutes to reflect upon how the disciples must have felt in the boat after Jesus awoke from sleep and calmed the wind and waves. He stilled natural elemental powers with just a few words, and they asked, "Who is this? Even the winds and waves obey him."
