Wisdom from Above

Several years ago, I was given a chart titled, "Managing Complex Change." It listed five items needed for healthy change, as well as what happens if one of those items is missing. For example, an "action plan" is needed for change, but if there isn't one, then a "treadmill" effect is created. Another would be, if there is no "vision," then "confusion" is created. Over the years I found it useful to refer back to this chart when organizing events, thinking about the future, or any of many other situations which might need change.

Eventually though, I noticed a shortcoming. Nothing in the chart promoted godly thinking or planning. To counter this, I decided to add a sixth category, "Spiritual Emphasis." This category is to make sure that planning for change involves thinking through the needed actions from a godly perspective. This means things like: praying for God's guidance, searching scriptures for guidance, or seeking godly counsel from others.

James' letter in the New Testament scriptures has many good insights for seeking wisdom. First, in James 1:5 he says, "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God...." There are many places to seek wisdom, but there is a huge difference between wisdom that comes from above (heaven) and wisdom that comes from below (earth). James contrasts these two wisdoms chapter 3. Wisdom from below is full of envy, selfish ambition, unspiritual and even demonic says James. Wisdom from above is peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy, impartial and sincere.

For those who profess to be followers of God, it is paramount to rely on godly wisdom in all things. This could include: financial planning, raising a family, deciding on careers, legal issues, or education programs. No matter what the issue, I want to encourage everyone, if you are at a place where you are making plans or need change in life, seeking wisdom from above.
