Sever and S.O.N.E. Students

We have just started a new session of classes the end of last month. We had to postpone the starting of classes due to back to back typhoons that shut down the boats and ships from traveling for over a week. We have 11 students enrolled, 6 of them are members of the church & 5 of them are local residents in the area. We have started this session of Seyer vocational training with automotive classes. The students will learn welding and baking as well, later on. All students are also enrolled in the S.O.N.E. Bible program as well and they have weekly classes. The two programs really complement each other, and we are able to use the Bible program as a way of evangelizing our neighbors who are wanting to join our Seyer Training Center vocational classes.

For the Seyer Training Center, our main teachers are Wilkin Carbona (automotive) and Benny Lirasen (welding). In S.O.N.E. we have Joemar Recomono, Klenn Mark Sotillo, Danny Regon, and myself.

We really appreciate the Seyer supporters and the Highland Lakes church of Christ at Kingsland, TX for helping fund the S.O.N.E. program. Your funds provide salary for the teachers; materials, food, basic needs, and fare for students; as well as cover the electricity and water bills for the students' dorm, machine shop, and welding center.
