#### **Nelson's Farm**

The Nelson Farm is located in Naval, Biliran, an area that was severely damaged by Yolanda, a major typhoon that struck the Philippines several years ago. We have just harvested a good crop of corn (the white variety for food- we grind it into corn grits that are eaten with every meal like rice). The corn is now being stored and dried behind the Naval Church. By the end of the month, rice will be harvested also. I will send the big Hino truck with Danny Regon to bring the corn to Negros to be milled, it will be used to feed our orphans and students with us. Corn and rice will also be distributed to those in need in Naval, the church will handle that share.

We appreciate Jane Nelson and her children for honoring Brother Ron Nelson, an elder and farmer, with helping us purchase the farm land in Naval. It has been and will continue to be a tremendous blessing to the orphans, students, and those in need. We are also thankful to the North Garland church members who helped us put in water irrigation system last year, so we can now get three harvests in a year, even in the dry season. The farm is self-sustaining, we keep a small portion of each harvest to sell, so that we can purchase more seed and pay the folks who help plant and harvest.
