A Cross-Shaped Life

There were three nails that held Jesus' body to the cross for our salvation. Actually it was His love that held him there. "This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins" (1 John 4:9-10 NIV).

The first nail stands for "<u>Selflessness</u>." Jesus' death on the cross was done out of complete selflessness. He willingly gave His life for us (John 10:17-18). Selfishness can be one of our greatest enemy's. Jesus' death on the cross demonstrates complete selflessness, which is crucial to a selfless life. Read Philippians 2:3-4.

The second nail stands for "<u>Sacrifice</u>." Jesus gave His life for us on the cross. The Apostle Paul said, "[Jesus] loved me and gave Himself for me" (Galatians 2:20). Jesus was the ultimate sacrifice that atoned for our sins. This nail in Jesus' cross should remind us of the sacrificial love that we are to have for one another.

The third nail stands for <u>"Surrender"</u>." Jesus surrendered His will to that of His heavenly Father. He prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will" (Matthew 26:39). It was the Father's will that Jesus die on the cross for the sins of the world; there was no other way to save mankind. May this nail in Jesus' cross always remind us that the greatest thing that we can do is to surrender our life to Christ.

When we apply these principles that are reflected in the nails of Jesus' cross to one's life, we can live the abundant, God-blessed life, filled with selflessness, sacrificial love, and surrender to the will of God.
