To live according to the "gospel of me" spells disaster. We know that we are not **GOD**, but sometimes to keep up our image, we act like it.

When we do everything our way, we have no opportunity to learn from others. We can be doomed to commit the same mistakes over and over again because we won't listen to or learn from others. Our horizons are too narrow.

"Our way" is undisciplined. It is a long line of urges, wants, and desires. Selfishness is not found around freedom. <u>Undisciplined people follow the path of least</u> <u>resistance</u>. The person who does only what he wants never completes difficult jobs. He is always behind and in debt.

Paul pleads for the maturity which comes by understanding that we have no reason to boast, for "grace was given to each of us according to the measure of Christ's gift" (Eph. 4:7). How can I boast of my accomplishments when I am "not my own" (1 Cor. 6:19). We were bought with Christ's blood. How can we be selfish when everything we have of value is a gift?

There is only room for one throne in our hearts. It will be occupied by <u>GOD</u> or self. When we enthrone ourselves, we dethrone GOD. "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve GOD and money" (Matt. 6:24).
