"A Disciple's Purpose"

As I reflect on life, there is a natural human need to be pleasing. As children, we want to be pleasing to our parents. When we go to school, we strive to be pleasing to our teachers. Being pleasing is indeed an important part of our lives, we put forth a lot of effort to achieve that feeling of fulfillment.
