Sermon Scripture: Daniel 4

**Sermon Thought**: When Daniel discovered the meaning King Nebuchadnezzar's dream, he gave the king an option, humble yourself or be humbled. # Came from Heaven to Earth

"Left the Glory of Heaven"

It is hard for us to comprehend the depth of love the Father showed us when **Christ came from Heaven to earth**. He came from the very place we are trying to get to. When you have the best of all creation, why would you give it up. There are two places in my life I find it difficult to leave – the beauty of the Hawaiian Islands and the majesty of the mountains. They are both inspiring and create in me a feeling of being closer to God. As hard as it is to leave these places, I must so God's will can be done in my life – just as it was in Christ.

John tells us that "God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (Jn. 3:16). Paul opens our eyes to the love of the Son too. "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men" (Phil. 2:5-7). I can't begin to imagine how hard it was for Christ when he left the glory of Heaven and came to earth – the beauty – the peace – the perfect harmony manifested in all things. But he did, so we can also enjoy the awesome grandeur of the Father's glory. Jesus said, "My food is to do the will of him who sent me, and to accomplish his work" (Jn. 4:14). If he had not left the glory of Heaven, we would be without hope of eternal life with the Father. Jesus came to earth so we can see the Father. As Jesus told Philip "He who has seen me has seen the Father" (Jn. 14:9). That means he came from Heaven to earth so we can be inspired by all the beauty and majesty we behold in those places that are near and dear to our hearts. May our spiritual lives be nourished in his glory with each and every breath we take.
