Came from Heaven to Earth

"Tempted As We Are"

The phrase "don't tempt me" is a stunning reality of life. Unfortunately, we are all tempted to do things we shouldn't as we journey through life. One temptation I remember is when Carol and I were married. I got some travelers checks for our honeymoon, and later discovered the bank had given me \$50 too much. O how I was tempted to keep it and go on because we didn't have much at that time, and I was going to Vietnam for a year. But the honesty my parents instilled in me took me back to the bank to let them know about the mistake. There had been a \$50 shortage in their balance for that day, but they could not specify what it was. Tempted again – I need it – but it is not mine! I gave it back believing God would care for our young lives and the financial needs we had.

Don't think we are by ourselves in being tempted. The Bible tells us that the Son of God was "tempted as we are, yet without sin" (Heb. 4:15). That means Jesus knows what we are going through when we are being tempted. He has been there – he has felt the temptations of the flesh – but the glory and perfection of the Father gave him the strength to overcome Satan's temptations. Paul gives us this assurance that we too can withstand when we are tempted. "No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your strength, but with the temptation will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it" (1 Cor. 12:13). Because Jesus was tempted as we are, he is there reaching out his hand to provide us that way of escape. He is our cheerleader assuring us we can resist – we can endure – we can overcome. When we feel Satan tempting us to do something we know we shouldn't, turn to Jesus for strength to resist and he will bless our lives beyond measure.
