# **God Humbles Us in Simple Ways**

Today while I was meeting a sister in Christ in the mall in Cebu to deliver some solar radios from Sunset to some preachers & workers who helped in the church planting last December in Samboan, I saw a small little girl about 2 years old with her mother. The little girl was very beautiful, with curly hair like the girl in the "Annie" movie. She had the sweetest smile, and bright eyes, that really touched my heart. I overheard her asking her mother to buy her some food to eat. She said, "Mama, I am hungry." The mother was sad in telling her she had no money to buy her something to eat. This happened inside the mall, next to a burger place in the food court. The little girl did not complain, she just went up and sat next to a family that was eating. She sat next to a young boy eating a hamburger, and just watched him appreciating what he had, wishing she had some too. She was so sweet in her demeanor, but she went unnoticed by the family, and they ignored her.

Something about the whole event, that happened in a matter of minutes, struck my heart and moved me almost to tears. I told the mother, as she got up to leave, to please wait a minute. There was a bakery where I was standing. I quickly bought some bread and gave it to the child. The child's face just lit up as she politely took the bread from me, she blessed my hand in the Filipino way that a child does to an older loved family member, to show her gratefulness. I saw the eyes of Jesus looking up at me, through this child. So unexpected for what I was supposed to be doing at the time, rushing around, trying to tie up loose ends before we fly to the states this week. Such a blessing and deep joy to let my heart be touched by this simple beautiful child. Thankful that God uses simple things to help us see His Words in living action, and it made me truly feel that my Christian life is worth living. Our God is truly alive! So many needs around us, simple, but important, that go unnoticed, that we as His servants can make a big difference if we allow God to use us as His instruments for good.

We look forward to visiting you all next month. We will be coming to visit you April 19-29. I look forward to sharing with you all what God has been able to do with your help, love, & prayers in the Philippines. What a partnership we have had since 1994!
