Blood Drive

Since there is no substitute for human blood and supplies must be constantly renewed, the need for donation is great. About three gallons of blood is required to support the entire nation's blood need for just one minute. One in seven people entering a hospital will need blood. *Although an estimated 38 percent of the U.S. population is eligible to donate blood at any given time, less than 10 percent do so annually.* Patients need blood 365 days-a-year, whether it's for scheduled treatments or for emergencies. The Oklahoma Blood Institute provides every drop of blood needed by patients in more than 160 medical facilities across the state. Although all blood types are needed, people with O-negative type blood are especially encouraged to donate. Only nine percent of the national population has O-negative blood; however, O-negative blood can be used in an emergency when a patient's blood type has not yet been identified. All healthy adults, ages 16 and older who meet weight requirements, are encouraged to give blood. Getting older does not make people ineligible to donate. North Garland will be hosting a Blood Drive May 1st, from 5-8 pm in the foyer. Let's help save lives!!
