No matter who we are or what we have become, we all have burdens we carry. No matter what they are, we have to find a way to work through them and keep them from destroying our lives. So where do we begin? It seems to me that the first step is to spend time reflecting on what our burdens are – and understanding how they weigh us down. Then we need to look for ways to deal with our burdens and lessen the impact they have on our lives – putting them behind and pressing on with the things we want to do.

I submit that the greatest obstacles we face in life is **the burden of sin**. Solomon teaches us "there is not a righteous man on earth who does good and never sins" (Ecc. 7:20). The apostle Paul affirms this when he writes "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23). When we have sin in our lives, it weighs us down – we feel like we can't go on – it drains our emotions and energy. **The burden of sin** is sure to destroy the goodness of life and keep us from being righteous before God. We need to stop and assess what sins we have in our lives and how they are keeping us from being joyful and happy. Praise God that his love provides us a way out of **the burden of sin**. As Peter writes, "He [Jesus] himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness" (1 Pet. 2:24). So Jesus calls us to lay **the burden of sin** at his feet and he will set us free (Matt. 11:28-29). "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the law of sin and death" (Rom. 8:2). How wonderful to have the heavy weight of sin lifted from our weary souls. We are now free to become the righteousness of God and enjoy eternal life with him. **Gordon-**
