

# **LCCC Update**

With summer fasting approaching and family routines changing, I wanted to give everyone a brief update on the church camp we support. If you are new to our church family, **LCCC** stands for Lariat Creek Christian Camp. It is supported by Churches of Christ in northwest and western Oklahoma. It is located just north of Geary, OK, on a small creek that runs through the property.

It was established at this site in 1973 and that is when many of the buildings were built. The camp is overseen by a board of men from different churches that support the camp. I have been on that board since the 1990s.

To improve the camp, the board started a very ambitious building campaign in 2013 to replace and improve the cabins, mess hall and kitchen, bath house, cook quarters and permanent home for the caretakers of the camp. Since that time, a new cabin has been built, Rick and Cathy (our caretakers) have a new log home, the new welcome center should be completed soon (June 2019), and new bath house is being completed (late 2019 or early 2020). All this comes with a cost. With camp improvement and expenses, the board will spend \$300,000 this year for those improvements.

This is a true labor of love. All of us on the board consider the camp as "kingdom" work. It touches not only the kids that go in the summertime, but the camp is used heavily by different churches for retreats, family reunions, and we also get requests for weddings. I just wanted to tell everyone THANK YOU, that has helped in the camp's success. Also, to encourage everyone to use the camp. Thanks to everyone that has or will send your children there.
