### Friendly Fire

How are we able to help others outside of the body of Christ if we can't figure out the disputes we have within it? Some of our biggest disagreements and hurts come from within the body of Christ.

I know most of us have heard Paul's words in Ephesians 4:26-27, "**26 Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, 27 and give no opportunity to the devil.**" but how many of us actually put it into practice? My pride and resentment towards others and the situation causes me to constantly delay my apology.

Jesus told his disciples in Luke 17:3-4, "*Pay attention to yourselves! If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him, and if he sins against you seven times in the day, and turns to you seven times, saying, I repent, you must forgive him.*" Another struggle of mine is taking rebuke. My worldly instinct is to go into defense mode and immediately point out something the person rebuking me is doing wrong. Instead, I should take the plank out of my eye, resolve that problem, before looking at the speck in their eye.

The world we live in today is full of unresolved and broken relationships. I pray that we can be a church that approaches one another in love in times of disagreement. I pray that if we are angry about something our brother or sister has done then we make amends with them before the end of the day, and when our brother or sister sins against us we rebuke them. All of this done in LOVE!
