Sermon Scripture: Genesis 37-50

Sermon Thought: Very few people in the Bible have as many chapters devoted to their life as Joseph does. The ripple effects of his life resulting in the Israelites ending up in Egypt, shape the rest of the scripture. First God rescues the Israelites from slavery to the Egyptians, then in the New Testament we see God's plan to rescue humanity from slavery to sin.

Sermon Questions:

1. As children we learned about Joseph and the coat of many colors. Most likely, as you got older, you learn the account of Joseph on a deeper level. What stands out to you most about the wild and crazy life of Joseph?
2. Had you been in Joseph's shoes (err...sandals), what would you have found most difficult and why?
3. Something that Joseph triumphed in was seeing God working on the grand scale. Too often we get caught up in the little things going wrong. How can we do a better job looking at the big picture in our lives?
