#### Milk or Meat?

Referring to another member of the acting profession, Minnie Pearl once said, "He isn't a failure. He just started at the bottom and liked it there." There are Christians who might fit the same description. We grow to a point of obedience to the Lord and then stop. We proudly take His name and promptly leave the game. Some Christians who should be savoring spiritual meat are still slurping from a baby bottle. Peter's admonition is simple and strong, "Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." -2 Peter 3:18

How are you growing in grace and knowledge? In what ways are you changing? Are you thinking, talking and living more like Jesus every day? Or did you start at the bottom and stay there? Don't let Satan lull you into liking it there! Everybody starts out as a baby, but nobody is designed to remain a baby. The church needs fewer people who act like infants, or who exhibit juvenile behavior. As one hymn sounds the challenge "Men of faith rise up and sing," then, "Rise up women of the truth." And let the words of another song encourage growth and development for all men (and women): "I'm pressing on the upward way; New heights I'm gaining every day; Still praying as I onward bound; 'Lord, plant my feet on higher ground."
