Sermon Scripture: Proverbs 28:13

Sermon Thought: Repentance involves recognizing that you have thought wrongly in the past and determining to think rightly in the future. The repentant person has "second thoughts" about the mindset he formerly embraced. There is a change of disposition which leads to a new way of thinking AND behaving.

Unashamed

Why is it that we, as Christians, often seem scared or ashamed to admit what we are and who we serve? Often people get scared because they don't want to be seen as a fanatic. Or people don't want to be known as "one of THOSE Christians". Our relationship with God should be so strong that being shamed shouldn't even be an afterthought, but that goes against our human nature. We desire to belong, and we make mistakes. Sometimes we treat our faith like a matter of **shame**.

However, as Christians we ought to have a shame-free relationship with God. For instance, look at Paul. Once a man driven by the desire to punish and kill Christians- now a powerful leader in the church driven by the desire to spread the story of Christ. Paul wasn't ashamed to tell people about Christ no matter the consequences. **Romans 1:16 says, "for I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation"**. Paul's entire life was to serve God and spread the message of Christ. **Philippians 1:21: "for me to live is Christ, and to die is gain"**. When we are out in the world, we need to be proud servants of God. Go out, tell the world of Christ, and be **Unashamed**.
