"The kingdom of heaven is like...." This is a familiar phrase to any who have read the words of Jesus. In fact, Matthew's gospel of Jesus Christ records over 30 instances of the phrase, "the kingdom of heaven." Within Jesus' teaching of the kingdom of heaven there are a few different themes. One prominent theme is that of mystery or maybe secrecy is a better word.

Consider the teachings in Matthew 13 specifically. In this chapter the kingdom of heaven is compared to a mustard seed that starts small and ends up big, yeast that works its way through dough unseen, treasure hidden in a field, and a fine pearl costing a merchant everything to attain it. Each of these comparisons contains an element of mystery.

It is especially the times when Jesus stresses the importance of seeking the kingdom that jump out to me. Being included in the kingdom of heaven is an option that is available to everyone. But it will not be obvious to all. It isn't glamorous, popular, or even obvious for that matter. It is actually just the opposite. If you think back to the pearl teaching, the merchant was left with nothing except his pearl. People would say you are crazy if you actually gave up everything you had for God.

Think about yourself...are you a part of God's secret kingdom? It really isn't a secret. It's just that the vast majority are so caught up looking for something else in life that they are going to miss it.

"The son of man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil. They will throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Whoever has ears, let them hear." -Matthew 13:41-43 Erik Granberg
