# Marriage Feast

#### Matthew 22:1-14 The Garment of Salvation

One of the questions usually asked when we are invited to attend some function is, "What is the dress?" We may generally have a good idea what it needs to be, but we still want to make sure we do not disappoint our host. It is very important that we are acceptable, and that we blend in with all the other guests. There is a scene in Jesus' parable of the marriage feast that has always bothered me. When he sent his servants to "Go therefore to the thoroughfares, and invite to the marriage feast as many as you can find" (Matt. 22:9). The wedding hall was filled with guests, but then the king "saw there a man who had no wedding garment... and he had him cast out into outer darkness" (vs. 11-13).

Wow! He was invited to come to the marriage feast, but when he did, he was cast out. Now the text doesn't say any of the invited guests asked what the dress was, but they all knew what it was. Knowing what was required, the other guests must have gone home and put on their wedding garments. Jesus is teaching us that we must be clothed in the right dress to be with him in his eternal glory. We must put on **the garment of salvation** to be able to attend the marriage feast with him and his church. Paul writes, "*For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ*" (Gal. 3:26). He invited us to come to him, to be buried with him in baptism and to walk in newness of life (Rom. 6:3-4). Jesus gave his life to pay for our sin debt, and he now instructs us to put on **the garment of salvation** so we can reign with him. "*For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God*" (2 Cor. 5:21). So, what do we need to wear to be saved? Christ Jesus our Lord! If we do not have **the garment of salvation**, we too will be cast out into outer darkness. *Gordon*
